HALL OF FAME GUIDELINES AND
NOMINATION FORM

Who is eligible?

1. The nominee must be, or have been an active participant in any segment of the Kentucky manufactured housing industry for a minimum of 20 years. The Selection Committee does have the power to choose a nominee who has earned selection while falling short of the 20 year threshold, but will exercise that power only in special circumstances.
2. The nomination form must be filled out in its entirety and must be accompanied by three supporting letters (no more, no less) that meet KMHI's guidelines for these letters. Incomplete nominations cannot be considered. If the nominee is not selected within 3 years, he or she remains eligible only if the nomination is resubmitted and refreshed with additional information.

What the Selection Committee is looking for?

Consideration will be given to the nominee's overall contributions to the good of the industry, to include both his/her positions, accomplishments and innovations on the job as well as volunteer work both inside and outside the industry, with special emphasis on volunteer work done on behalf of state and national associations and owner groups, and other industry-related organizations and causes. Favorable responses to these two basic questions are good starting points for the Selection Committee's consideration: 1) Is the nominee a respected, accomplished, honorable person who has done right by his business partners? and 2) Has the nominee contributed to the good of the industry beyond doing his job well?

How does the process work?

Anyone can nominate anyone. If a completed nomination form and three properly-prepared supporting letters are received by February 1st, the nominee will be in a pool of candidates considered for the upcoming Hall of Fame and President's Awards Dinner in June and two years beyond that. The Selection Committee will make their recommendations to the Board at its first quarterly meeting. The KMHI's Hall of Fame policy allows two inductees per year.

NOMINATION FORM

This form must be submitted by February 1st for your candidate to be considered in the pool of potential inductees. Your nomination will be valid for 3 years from date of submission.

This nomination **requires** three (3) one-page letters of support for your nominee (no more) to accompany this nomination application.

Guidelines for Letters of Support

- A) Is the nominee a respected, accomplished, honorable person who has done right by his business affiliates?
- B) Has the nominee contributed to the good of the industry beyond doing his job well?
