

<u>Trade and Apprenticeship Student Scholarship</u>

Five (5) \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to individuals who are currently attending or will be attending a technical center, trade school, or enrolling in an apprenticeship program centered around the construction industry.

Application Instructions

A completed application must be accompanied by the following:

- an original, type-written 300-word (no less) essay explaining why you want to enter the construction industry, and what you hope to obtain from your schooling and/or training to prepare you as you start your career
- a copy of your high school, GED, or college transcript
- three letters of reference from business professionals, clergy, or community leaders only one reference may be from a school administrator or teacher

<u>Deadline</u>

To be considered, the completed application, type-written 300-word essay, and three letters of references must be postmarked to KMHI by April 15, 2024.

Award Selection

Selection is based on the essay, scholastic grades, community involvement, honors, personal goals, and references. The judges' decision is final. Alternates are selected and move to first place, should a winner be disqualified, receive a full scholarship from another source, or decide not to further his/her education. A tie may result in an inperson interview. <u>Recipients not chosen will be notified via mail by the end of May.</u>

Manufactured Home Resident Scholarship

Two (2) \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors, GED recipients, or students who are currently enrolled in college, technical school, or trade school. Eligible participants must live in a modular or manufactured home.

Application Instructions

A completed application must be accompanied by the following:

- an original, type-written 300-word (no less) essay explaining the impact factory-built housing has had on your life
- a copy of your high school, GED, or college transcript
- three letters of reference from business professionals, clergy, or community leaders only one reference may be from a school administrator or teacher

<u>Deadline</u>

To be considered, the completed application, type-written 300-word essay, and three letters of references must be postmarked to KMHI by April 15, 2024.

Award Selection

Selection is based on the essay, scholastic grades, community involvement, honors, personal goals, and references. The judges' decision is final. Alternates are selected and move to first place, should a winner be disqualified, receive a full scholarship from another source, or decide not to further his/her education. A tie may result in an inperson interview. <u>Recipients not chosen will be notified via mail by the end of May.</u>
